# **BPRW Recognizes National Wellness Month**



ugust marks National Wellness Month, a time to focus on our overall health and well-being. During this month, we encourage everyone to take care of their minds and bodies by getting enough sleep, eating a wellbalanced diet, staying physically

active or trying something new. We also shine a light on two important observances for our community: Minority Donor Awareness Month and Black Breastfeeding Week.

Minority Donor Awareness month aims to increase organ donation rates among minority communities, improving health outcomes and saving lives. According to the Office of Minority Health, African Americans make up the largest group of minorities in need of an organ transplant. In 2021, non-Hispanic blacks made up 12.1 percent of the national population.

Black Breastfeeding Week, which

takes place August 25th - 31st, seeks to raise awareness about the breastfeeding disparities among Black families. Breastfeeding is a crucial aspect of maternal and child health, yet Black mothers face significant barriers to breastfeeding success. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), only 77.3% of non-Hispanic Black infants are ever breastfed, compared to higher rates among Asian (87.1%), non-Hispanic White (85.3%), and Hispanic infants (81.9%).

### **Power Profiler: Kamala Harris**



Kamala D. Harris is the Vice President of the United States. She always fights for the people - from her barrier-breaking time as **District** Attorney of San Francisco and Attorney General of California, to proudly serving as a United States Senator and the Vice President.

On January 20, 2021, Kamala Harris was sworn in as Vice President - the first woman, the first Black American, and the first South Asian American to be elected to this position. With withdrawal of President Joe Biden from the 2024 U.S. presidential election, Kamala Harris secured enough non-binding support from delegates to

become the presumptive nominee of the Democratic Party in the 2024 presidential election.

As Vice President, she has worked to bring people together to advance opportunity, deliver for families, and protect fundamental freedoms

across the country. She has led the fight for the freedom of women to make decisions about their own bodies, the freedom to live safe from gun violence, the freedom to vote, and the freedom to drink clean water and breathe clean air. While making history at home, she is also representing the nation abroad embarking on more than a dozen foreign trips, traveling to more than 19 countries, and meeting with more than 150 world leaders to strengthen critical global alliances.

The Vice President has been a trusted partner to President Joe Biden as they work together to deliver monumental achievements that are lifechanging for millions of Americans.
